14. BELLA SKYWAY FESTIVAL







The mapping displayed on the facade of the Marshal's Office is made in a special technique, thanks to which the portraits of famous people will come to life and perform an unprecedented musical show for the spectators gathered at Teatralny Square. No one had ever seen the outstanding astronomer from Toruń singing and dancing to the song *Starman* – David Bowie or Pola Negri directing a fiery confession addressed to Charlie Chaplin, thanks to the words of the song *Red Corals*. Among the outstanding personalities, there will be, of course, the most famous Polish astronomer – Nicolaus Copernicus. In addition to him, the mapping will also feature other historical figures who have had connections with the current voivodship throughout history.

The Super Copernicus video mural will tell the story of the famous astronomer's life and achievements in an intriguing way. Video art displayed in public space is an unobvious form of transferring historical knowledge. But this is where the power of the Super Copernicus video art message lies. Each of us knows that it was the astronomer from Toruń who "stopped the Sun and moved the Earth". But what else do we know about our compatriot? The creators of the video mural will set themselves the task of disseminating knowledge not only about Copernicus, but also about Toruń itself and its beautiful old town, which is the venue of the festival.

"Some people live in a dream world. Others – they look at reality. There are also those who turn one into the other." The American athlete Douglas Everett aptly divided people into those who rock in the clouds and those who have their feet firmly on the ground. With all this, he did not forget to mention us – people who can transform ordinary everyday life into a land of dreams. For chemists, a soap bubble is simply a film formed from a mixture of soap and water. For artists, it is a symbol of evanescence, which Jacob van Loo presented in his paintings. However, for a child it is more than a round form in transparent multicolors. It is an undiscovered mystery, a fascinating phenomenon and a pinch of magic transferred to reality. Soap bubbles have always accompanied dreamers. This is tangible proof that the fantasy world really exists! We are sure that even Nicolaus Copernicus himself saw in them a Wonderland enclosed in a transparent capsule.





Meadow of Dreams is a colorful installation depicting several hundred flowers made of recycled plastic bottles. By creating a magical meadow, the artist introduces the viewer into the world of children's dreams, evokes pleasant memories of contact with nature. However, the colorful project also hides an unpleasant truth about our planet – the bottles needed to make it were collected in a very short time by the artist's family and friends. The installation therefore encourages reflection on the need to reduce the production of plastic so that future generations can enjoy real nature, not artificially created.





ECOLOGICAL PARTNER



From the very beginning, the festival of light in Toruń has been cooperating not only with world-renowned artists, but also with local and young artists, thus giving them a chance to present their skills and appear in the world of art. The "Bella Young Graphic Design Award" competition gives young artists specializing in design, drawing and graphic design a chance to present their skills. The creators were tasked with creating design projects inspired by the leitmotiv of this year's Festival: "Dreamers from the green planet", referring to the patron of 2023 – Nicolaus Copernicus and ecology. The installation presents the works of 10 finalists who qualified for the second stage, in which the festival audience will decide on the award. **Votes for the selected work can be cast in the plebiscite at https://www.bellaskyway.pl/award/.**





The Copernicus Star is a spectacle based on fantastic animations showing the planets observed by Nicolaus Copernicus and extrasolar worlds, which in some way (e.g. through naming) are related to the figure and work of our greatest scientist from Toruń. The whole thing is enriched with narration and music track. The authors are well-known and respected promoters of astronomy, creators of radio and television programs, animators of events devoted to knowledge about the Universe: Piotr Majewski – radio host, Master of Polish Speech and Jerzy Rafalski – astronomer from the Planetarium Toruń, author of books. Both of them have been running the biweekly "Radio Planet i Komet" on Polish Radio PiK for years.

The play of lights, 3D animations and music create a beautiful spectacle, stimulating reflection on transience. The installation also refers to ecology, prompting viewers to think about the impact on the environment and the need to protect our planet. In mapping, there are images showing the destruction of the natural environment, climate change and other problems that the Earth is facing. *Time Gate* is not only an aesthetic decoration of public space, but also a kind of symbol that encourages reflection on time, its passage and meaning in our lives.

The sun is considered as a creative force that conditions life on Earth. It refers to infinity, energy and heat. It is a symbol of light, fire, truth, knowledge, enlightenment, wisdom and glory from ancient times to the present day. The sun is associated with fertility, justice, but also with ancient religions, e.g. Christianity, in which the symbol of the cross was the original sacred solar sign, and the literal artifact of form is the monstrance. Today, sunlight is associated with life, joy and happiness, but also with the greenhouse effect that we have created ourselves. The installation will be presented in the courtyard of the Old Town Hall in Toruń, becoming a symbolic center of the universe.

The soundtrack that accompanies the experience adds to the magical atmosphere, making you feel like you're truly exploring the universe. The best part? You're not alone. Everyone around you is experiencing the same thing, and you can share your excitement with them. This augmented reality experience brings people together in a unique and unforgettable way. Scan the code on the special totems by the fountain and experience something extraordinary.





Sol is a light installation inspired by the astronomical phenomenon of a solar eclipse. Once associated with the wrath of the gods, a harbinger of misfortune and arousing fear among the ancients – today it is an aesthetic experience that inspires the creation of stunning photographs. The presented work captures the moment of the emergence of the sun's disc from the shadow of the moon – the awakening. It is the end of the eclipse when the brightest star in our solar system regains its rightful place in the firmament and illuminates the Earth once again, bringing hope and reminding us that darkness always passes. The work was carried out thanks to the scholarship of the Minister of Culture and National Heritage.

Each person should live in full harmony with their elements, which give them the strength to act. The installation is a reflection on the harmony of man with the whole world, i.e. with the five elements that are part of everything in the universe. The artist wants to show how valuable and inseparable the connection between man and nature is and how important it is to take care of the world around us so that people can live on Earth for centuries to come. The work aims to stimulate awareness and care for the natural environment in the viewers. The harmonious combination of installation elements will show visitors that taking ecologically sustainable solutions is possible and even necessary.





Waste symbiosis is a simplified view into the depths of the ocean. It aims to draw the public's attention to the destructive human activity in the era of consumerism, which directly affects the still escalating problem of sea and ocean pollution. The aim of the artists is to draw the recipient's attention to the problem of water pollution and to inspire reflection and motivation to act. The work is intended to arouse empathy among visitors, but also understanding and determination in the fight against water pollution. Waste symbiosis is a "window" to what is hard to see by people living in cities on a daily basis. It is both a warning and a moment for reflection on how we collectively litter the place where we live. The installation is an inspiration for a deeper involvement of the viewer in the protection and repair of water quality.





We are all dreamers, and any wish, no matter how large, has transformative power and can make positive changes in our lives. In Japanese culture, cranes are a symbol of prosperity, which are considered birds of luck and can help achieve the dreams. According to tradition, the person who folds 1,000 origami cranes will be given the opportunity to fulfill their innermost wish. The installation emphasizes the urgent need to act for environmental protection and becomes an appeal to take action for the Earth – our common good. The rising cranes show that it is time to take our environmental dreams to the next level. It is an invitation to engage and together take up the challenge that the Earth itself has set before us – the challenge of transforming and nurturing our planet so that it is a place full of life, harmony and beauty. Everyone who stands in front of the installation should feel that they have the power to influence the future of the Earth and contribute their symbolic "crane" to environmental protection. Mother Earth is waiting so much for the missing thousandth bird to fulfill her greatest dream.

Animals is an interactive land-art installation highlighting the beauty of the nature, more specifically of the eyes of animals living both above the ground and in the water. Armenian photographer Suren Manvelyan created an impressive collection of high resolution photos of animal eyes and this material served to Czech innovator Ivo Opl as a base for creation of this interactive installation. Visitors can observe on 40+ devices eyes of 16 animal spices like: Caiman, Chimpanze, Muflon, Raven, Zebrafish. As in real life animals are sensitive on distraction and will hide if you can't be silent enough. Some are shyer some can switch into the offensive mode. But don't worry they don't bite. The whole installation consists of 40 recycled smart phones.
